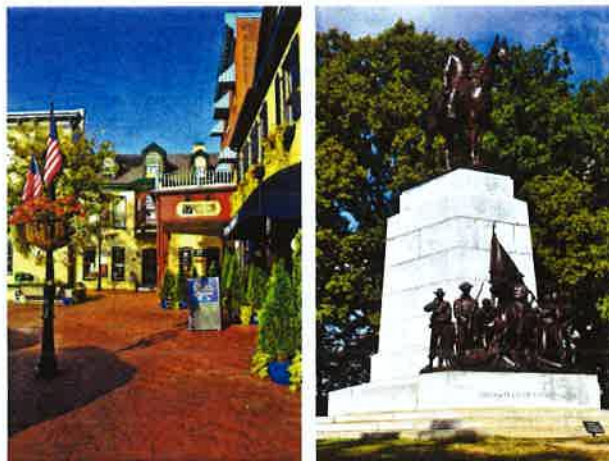
GUIDED TOURS ACROSS THE BATTLEFIELDS
